Course consists of three prerequisite sessions and three classroom sessions that include practice-teaching.

This course begins with the following three online prerequisite sessions that you will need to complete before the first session of the instructor course on November 12th.

1. Orientation to the American Red Cross
2. Orientation to First Aid/CPR/AED Instructor Course
3. First Aid/CPR/AED Instructor Pre-course Test

To get started with the prerequisite sessions, go to the instructor candidate area on Instructor's Corner on the web as follows: instructorscorner.org/FACPRAEDcandidates

If you do not complete the prerequisite online sessions, you will not be eligible to attend the instructor course. **Print off the online acknowledgement and bring to class.**

You will be given two practice-teaching assignments that will provide experience in presenting information in a discussion or lecture format using audiovisual equipment, conducting skill sessions and evaluating skill performance. A certified instructor trainer will evaluate you during your practice-teaching assignments.

At the end of the course, you will take an instructor written exam covering the information taught in the course and found in the instructor's manual.

To receive certification as a First Aid/CPR/AED instructor you must:

1. Complete online prerequisites
2. Attend all sessions
3. Actively participate in course activities
4. Successfully complete practice-teaching
5. Score at least 80 percent on the instructor written exam
